The Winery

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

Bold in appearance, this Cab delivers a nose of blackberry, sweet black cherries, and smoky oak. The full and rich palate is supported by firm ripe tannin and vanilla. The 13% Merlot lends some intense ripe jam flavors. The finish gently lingers with a touch of the toasty oak.
