The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

The Philosophy

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

Dark, viscous and deep red in color, with a nose that is balanced with dark fruits, oak, earth and cola. Hints of black pepper lie in the aromatics along with plum jam. A bold and full mouth house sweet currant, blackberry, vanilla, oak and chocolate. All this ends with supporting chalky tannin and tart berry.
