Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

Vibrant deep red and youthful in appearance, this blend has a nose of spicy licorice, blackberry, and plum. It has a chalky texture with dark fruits, toasty oak, vanilla, and caramel. The firm oak finish shows the potential for significant mellowing in a short time.
