The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

The Vineyard

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

The Philosophy

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

This red brick hued Meritage has a nose of sweet oak and candied black fruits. Full of flavors such as black cherry, brambleberry and distinct blueberry supported by vanilla and toffee. The mouth is succulent and the finish is long and spicy. The 33 months of aging has helped create a wine where oak has seeped into every corner of the profile.
