The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

The Vineyard

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

The Philosophy

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

This wine has a solid color and long "tears" which indicates its rich flavor. The nose is dominated by strawberry, cherry and red berry framed by toasty oak and hints of cinnamon and nutmeg. A structured mouth is highlighted by raspberry cream, ripe cranberry and soft tannin. The silky back palate leads to a full and rich yet clean finish.
