The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

The Vineyard

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

The Philosophy

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

Spring blossoms of honeysuckle, orange and sweet jasmine open this pale straw colored Riesling. A bright balance between residual sugar and acidity leaning toward the sweet side give the wine a full body. Flavors of nectarine, apricot and vanilla chai spice are indicative of German Riesling and strike a nice balance between California's fruit forward style and the German Alsace style of crisp, steely acid. -Alec Franks
