### The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

### The Vineyard

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

### The Philosophy

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

### Winemaker's Notes

A fresh and vibrant pale hue leads you to aromas of apricot, floral peach blossoms and very light toast. The full palate is lush with ripe grapefruit, pineapple and mild coconut with a hint of sweet pea. The finish is crisp and citrus clean with a tiny twang of sweetness on the end.
