The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

The Vineyard

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

The Philosophy

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

The Pt. Verdot in this blend gives a distinct aroma of concord grape and tones of licorice, cherry fruit and a nice mineral undertone. The Sangiovese lends a jazzy, red fruit component while the cabernet lends layers of black fruit. The chalky tannins contributes the backbone of the finished supported by lightly toasted oak and opulent acidity.
