### The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

### Winemaker's Notes

This light straw colored Riesling opens with spicy notes, floral aromas and ripe peach. The balance in its structures opens flavors of apricot, mango and vanilla custard. The palate is left clean yet lightly sweet well representing a great California Riesling. Asian fare will highlight the delicate aromatics and fruity spice of this 2010 vintage.
