The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

The more we harvest our new clones of Sauvignon Blanc the more exciting we become. This wine displays a beautifully floral and fruity nose of tangerine, grapefruit and orange blossoms. The creamy texture and hints of tropical fruit are balanced wonderfully with the subtle and elegant oak. This Sauv. Blanc exits with a bright flash but not acidic rush on the palate.
