The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

The Vineyard

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

The Philosophy

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

This Syrah has a dark and deep purple color with slow and long legs. The complex aromas of cedar, licorice, cola and spicy plum lead into a full palate dominated by cherry liqueur by the Petit Syrah. This bold and rich wine finishes with hints of black fruit and subtle notes of currant, herbed game and toasty oak.
