### The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

### The Vineyard

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

### The Philosophy

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

### Winemaker's Notes

An unmistakably ripe pear aroma is complimented with sugar snap, mineral and a unique sage-like herbal character. The mouth is rich with flavors of pear nectar, sweet grass, honeydew melon and tropical notes. The finis is nice and long, yet not over-lingering and is accented with sweet mandarin.
