The Winery

Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

The Philosophy

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

This Riesling opens with a blast of nectarine and pear concentrate that is complimented by touches of rose petal & spicy caramel. As this medium sweet wine rolls over the palate, ripe fig and sweet lime dominate the flavor with hints of honeydew melon and peach preserves. With a balance of high acidity and high residual sugar this wine finishes crisp.
