Located on the Foxen Canyon Wine trail in Santa Barbara County, California, the winery is part of a 38,000 acre ranch. Rancho Sisquoc Winery is proud to have been hand crafting wines since 1972.

Our vineyard is comprised of over 300 acres planted on south facing slopes on the Sisquoc River. Unique microclimates allow us to grow several varieties, and to produce grapes that offer distinct flavor and quality.

Our winemaking philosophy is a simple one: We create high quality wines in limited quantities, and offer them at a reasonable price.

Winemaker's Notes

Sylvaner is a wine that is unique to Rancho Sisquoc as we are the only producers of this varietal in California. The palate introduces itself with mulled spices, peaches, gingersnap and a beautiful bouquet of flowers and coconut with hints of brown sugar. The finish leaves you with a tangy sensation of sweet lime. Perfect for summer sipping.
