A deep ruby color with a nose of red dried fruit and herbs. Soft red fruit on the palate with lightly toasted oak and a subtle, clean finish.

Delicious with roasted pork loin rubbed with rosemary and garlic.

'Dried leather, baked blackberry, wet clay and hints of dried flowers show on the nose of this bottling. There's a fresh zing of acidity on the sip, where tart flavors of black plum, elderberry and lavender are framed by chalky tannins across a food-friendly, lightly-bodied mouthfeel.' –M.K.
