WINEMAKERS NOTES

The 2019 Rancho Sisquoc Cabernet makes a statement. It's everything one wants in a cabernet, yet, adds Sisquoc's unique character and terroir. Deep, rich red and blue fruits, cassis, with a hint of tobacco on the nose are carried over into the palette. Expect to find other notes as well like pepper, graphite, and wet stone. This wine is big on rich flavors and plush, supple tannins round-out the mouthfeel.
