# 2019 Malbec

## WINEMAKERS NOTES

Malbec may not top the charts in wine pop culture. But, it has a strong, loyal fan base. We suspect the 2019 vintage may add to the fan club. Flavors of black fruits, with a hint of tobacco on the nose, fade into a long, lingering finish of coffee, wet stone and even graphite at the very end. This vintage is simply decadent. However, the ripe acidity and bold tannins keep this wine from resembling a dessert bar. She's complex, and given her bold structure, we suspect will age gracefully. If you wanna be in the know now, then decant before serving.
