NOTES

Bright cherry dominates the palate and nose with a menagerie of red fruit. Other essences settle in with flavors and smooth textures of vanilla cream soda, hints of cola, and an undercurrent of cinnamon. With a few swirls of the glass a bouquet of light toasty oak emerges.

The bright acidity suggests this wine will age well, However, this wine is ready to be paired with smoky grilled marbled meats right now.
