## WINEMAKERS NOTES

Our 2021 Pinot Noir is the latest iteration of our past beloved Pinot vintages. This dark scarlet wine with soft pink edges draws attention visually and will hook the most olfactory arbiter with its notes of bright red fruits, including strawberry followed by faint, light, and mysterious wafts of clove and cedar. Dried cranberry, pomegranate, and vanilla are prominent on the palate, followed by wet stone and a hint of fig. This light and bright Pinot boasts a long finish carried by a beautiful balance of acids and tannins which dutifully carries the fruit and spice flavors.
