# 2021 RIESLING

## WINEMAKERS NOTES

On the nose aromas of melon, honeysuckle, cider are followed by the signature scent of petrol. These scents are carried into the palate as flavors of pear, apple are met with a pleasing compliment of orange rind-like bitterness and honeysuckle. We've ticked-down the residual sugar of our Rieslings over the past few vintages with the 2021 being at .8%. Simply stated, we love the results. The pleasing acidity carries the sugar to give a crispness that is rounded to a smooth mouthfeel. Normally, we'd peg Riesling to be a good picnic wine. However, this vintage elevates this wine to the dinner table or for an evening out at your favorite restaurant. Dress it up. Or dress it down; it's still a great choice for that lazy afternoon picnic.
