WINEMAKER NOTES

Gorgeous dried red fruits such as strawberry ride atop a slight undercurrent of vanillin and wet stone on the nose. Cherry, pomegranate, strawberry, sage, and cedar satiate the palate. Soft, but present tannins lightly hug the mouth the moment this plush wine touches the taste buds.
