# **2021 SAUVIGNON BLANC**

#### \$22.00 Wine Club Price \$19.80

Our Sauvignon Blanc is sourced from a 1.5 acre block of our Flood Family vineyard and is 100% single clone (530). Tropical fruits leap from the glass with notes of guava, passion fruit, and melon leading the profile. The palate is true to the aromas as guava and tropical fruits are followed by a slight hint of lime, honey, and nectar. Our Sauvignon Blanc receives a short aging of 4 months in French oak barrels that adds to this wine's complexity, and delivers smooth voluminous mouthfeel to carry the tropical acidity.

# **2018 CHARDONNAY**

## \$24.00 Wine Club Price \$21.60

This vibrant wine hints at its Santa Barbara Chardonnay character with an appearance of bright straw and fragrant aromas of citrus, Asian pear, and a bouquet of soft vanilla. On the palate, grilled lemon dominates and is tamed with fresh pear and apple. The fruit acidity is followed by a clean finish of marzipan, vanilla, notes of soft oak and even a hint of mint. **91 Points and Gold Medal** at the 2021 Orange County Wine Competition.

# **2020 SYLVANER**

## \$18.00 Wine Club Price \$16.20

**Double Gold at the 2022 San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition.** Sylvaner hides flavors not immediately evident in its pale-yellow color with silvery edges. However, the aromas of this wine unveil her secrets with melon and papaya prevalent on the nose. The flavors are in-line with the aromas as tropical fruits, like papaya and starfruit, are ever-present. Although not all is revealed as the tropical acidity of this wine hides the .7% residual sugar and leads to an easy-drinking mouthfeel.

## **2019 RIESLING**

## \$16.00 Wine Club Price \$14.40

The 2019 Riesling is near and dear to Rancho Sisquoc is made completely from our old vines planted in 1970. Fitting to legacy and tradition, the taste profile is classic Riesling. The pale straw-colored wine leads to aromas of orange blossom, soft-floral perfume and a signature hint of petrol. Tropical flavors of pineapple and banana are rounded by honey-like sweetness from the residual sugar that balance the wine's acids giving it a luscious mouthfeel.

## **2018 PINOT NOIR**

#### \$32.00 Wine Club Price \$28.80

Silver Medal at the 2021 Orange County Wine Competition. The 2018 Pinot Noir is blooming with floral notes and dried raspberry. Light in body and rich in color, with vibrant strawberry, wet stone and sweet oak and a touch of cedar to finish the palette.

## **2018 MERLOT**

#### \$25.00 Wine Club Price \$22.50

**90** Points, Wine Enthusiast Magazine. Silver, 2021 San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition. An alluring ruby color leads to a nose of red, dried fruit and herbs. Soft, red fruit on the palate with lightly toasted oak and a clean finish make this a great wine to pair with food or as an easy-drinker on its own. Aged 20 months in French oak. 100% Merlot.

#### 2018 SYRAH

#### \$28.00 Wine Club Price \$25.20

Notes of jammy dark fruits such as black currant, blackberries, and plum. You may also experience cloves and spice on the nose with a bright, fresh minerality that carries notes of soft vanilla. Sage brush and pepper give this Syrah a truly fascinating finish. Aged 18 months in 30% new French oak.

# **2017 SISQUOC RIVER RED**

## \$22.00 Wine Club Price \$19.80

Created exclusively for our Tasting Room and not available in retail stores. This inviting blend has aromas of baked blackberry pie, bright red fruit and vanilla. Crisp acidity with flavors of pomegranate, red fruits, coconut, and a hint of green peppercorn. Aged 22 months in French and American oak. 39% Syrah, 22% Malbec, 21% Merlot, 16% Cabernet Sauvignon, 2% Pt. Verdot, 1% Sangiovese.

# 2019 TRE VINI

## \$30.00 *Wine Club Price* \$27.00

#### Best in Class winner of the 2022 San Francisco Wine Chronicle Wine Competition. 91 Points in Wine Enthusiasts.

This garnet gem of a wine starts with deep blue fruits on the nose followed by an immediate spiciness. The aromas and bouquet are no tease, as the palate opens with dark berry fruits and baking spices and floral notes on the end. However, this is no over-ripe fruit bomb, as the Sangiovese lends acidity and dried red fruits to keep things interesting. This wine has plenty of weight and its tannins suggest this wine will age beautifully. 46% Sangiovese, 28% Syrah and 26% Cabernet Sauvignon. Aged for 18 months in French oak barrels.

# WINE CLUB #18 MERLOT

#### \$28.00 Wine Club Price \$25.20

Forget what you think you know about Merlot! When sampling barrels the wine making crew was intrigued by the Merlot Clones 181 & 01 that were from one single Block #4 (a 6.6-acre specific area) of our estate McMurray Vineyard. These barrels were special this vintage, not just among Merlot, but of all our varietals. We decided to showcase their exceptional, complex flavors by making a wine from this single small section of the vineyard and sharing them with our Wine Club Members. Deep, red and violet colors with red fruits, sweet oak, and a floral nose. Dried herbs, plum, and soft tannins meet for a plush, soft and balanced finish. Aged 18 months in 30% New Oak.

# 2018 MALBEC

## \$32.00 Wine Club Price \$28.80

Silver at the 2021 San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition. Malbec is not a wine one comes across often in Santa Barbara County. But if you know, you know. Vibrant, ripe black fruits, espresso, tobacco, and spice supported by a well-structured mouthfeel make for a rich, juicy, velvety, and dare I say "dank" wine. Aged 20 months in French oak.

# **2019 CABERNET FRANC**

## \$32.00 Wine Club Price \$28.80

This ruby red wine has aromas that fall in line with its appearance: red fruits that are followed by a bouquet of sweet oak, spice, and pepper. Bright red fruits are prominent with strawberry pushing through followed by dry herbs and that signature Cab Franc pepperiness.

# **2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON**

## \$34.00 *Wine Club Price* \$30.60

The 2019 Rancho Sisquoc Cabernet makes a statement. It's everything one wants in a cabernet, yet, adds Sisquoc's unique character and terroir. Deep, rich red and blue fruits, cassis, with a hint of tobacco on the nose are carried over into the palate. Expect to find other notes as well like pepper, graphite, and wet stone. This wine is big on rich flavors and plush, supple tannins round out the mouthfeel.

# 2017 CELLAR SELECT MERITAGE

## \$36.00 Wine Club Price \$32.40

A classic Cellar Select Meritage from Rancho Sisquoc. We blend the best barrels of our Bordeaux varietals to earn the Meritage label. Dark garnet in color, rich red fruits on the nose. A menagerie of rich, red fruits is balanced with smooth, luxuriant oak that is aged for 28 months. The structure of this wine allows for aging as well.

33% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Merlot, 17% Malbec, 17% Petit Verdot.
