## 2020 PINOT NOIR

### WINEMAKERS NOTES

The 2020 Pinot Noir has been a hit with critics and leads the stage after following the well-received 2019 vintage. Deep in color with a ruby red body fading to soft, pink edge show this wine is still young. Vibrant red fruits of raspberry and dried strawberry are bold in the nose with subtle essences of clove and violet candy as well. Fresh strawberry is prominent on the palate that is chased by raspberry, bright plum, dried fruits, rose petal, and clove and hints of anise. The acidity of the red fruits is exuberant and plays well with the soft, but present, tannins which leave a lingering dried fruit and spice finish.
